1. Psykoanalytisk perspektiv/tilknytningsperspektiv (mor-barn relasjon, fravær/Bowlby, Ainsworth, McIntosh m fl)
2. Kjønnrolle-perspektiv (far-barn relasjon, fravær av far/Lamb, Kelly, Warshak m.fl.)
3. Systemisk perspektiv (relasjonen til begge etter brudd, fungering/temperament, kognitiv utvikling, konsistens i samværsystemet og det totale antall omsorgspersoner/ Kline, Pruitt m.fl)

Forskning designes og fortolkes i disse rammene. Viktig for oss å være orientert om resultater og eventuelle begrensninger, noe FOSAP mener å ha gjort i folderen Samvær 0-3, der følgende litteratur, erfaringer fra deltagerne på seminar 2013, samt foredrag på nevnte seminar ligger til grunn.
